Year 9 Teenage Boosters

If your child is in Year 9, please complete the eConsent link, sent our via email, before 9am on 20th January 2025. Failure to complete a consent form will not be taken as a refusal. Pupils without consent may be allowed to selfconsent on the day if a health professional deems them to have sufficient understanding and competence to fully appreciate what's involved. Only those who are clearly comfortable in receiving the immunisation will have it. If parents/guardians respond and refuse consent, then the decision cannot be overruled by a young person, and they will not be vaccinated.
