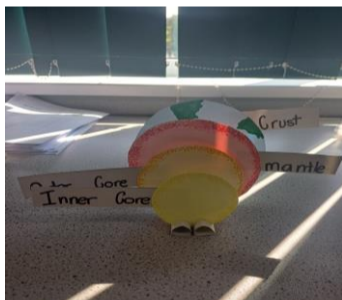

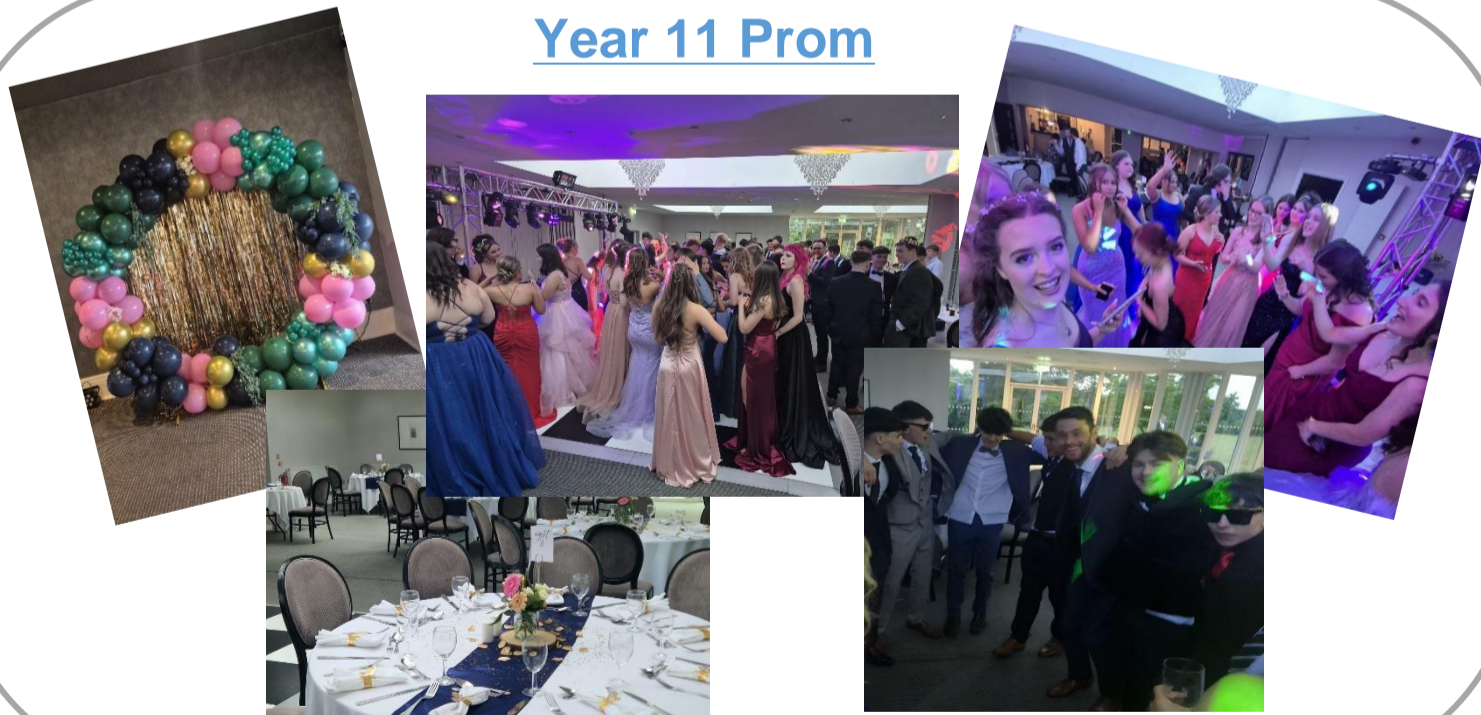
Year 10 Football
