## What will I study?

Macroeconomics looks at the whole economy and explores what techniques the government can employ to maintain a successful and sustainable economy.

## What career and university options can it lead to?

This subject could lead to a career in accountancy, management consultancy, teaching, banking and finance, trading or business management.
