**Reference: Latest return to school information**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the latest Government guidance on students returning to school, we wanted to inform you how students at our school will return.

**What will happen from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021?**

On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January, children of **critical** workers (the government's definition of a critical worker can be found [here](#)), and those classed as vulnerable will return to school for a full time, on-site provision.

If you received communication from your Head of Year or our Inclusion team on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2020, we will expect your child in school on 4<sup>th</sup> January.

If you are a critical worker and have not managed to complete the survey please access it [here](#) . If you are having issues accessing, please use your child's email address to log in.

Students in Year groups 11 and 13 will access a full, live, remote education via Teams.

Students in Year groups 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12 will have access to some remote learning but this will not be a live lesson and will be available from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Please ask your child to check their school email account as teachers will be sending them instructions.

**What will happen from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021?**

Students in Year groups 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12 will access a full, remote education via Teams.

Students in Year groups 11 and 13 will attend school for a full time, on site provision.

**What will happen from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2021?**

All students will return to school from all year groups.

**Testing for Covid-19**

Details on how your child will receive a test will be communicated to you next week.
