British Airways Virtual Insight Event (Monday 14th November 2022)

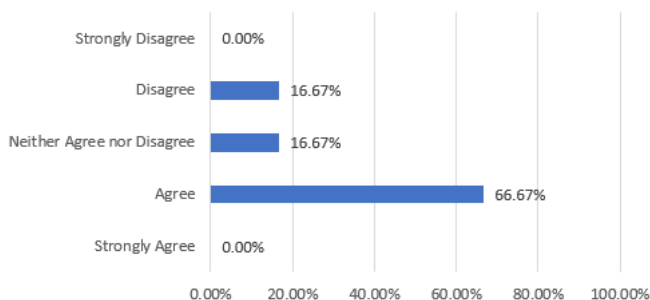
Outline of the Event

Young Professionals organized a virtual event with British Airways to provide a talk for students on the career pathways available at British Airways. Students accessed this event in their own time.

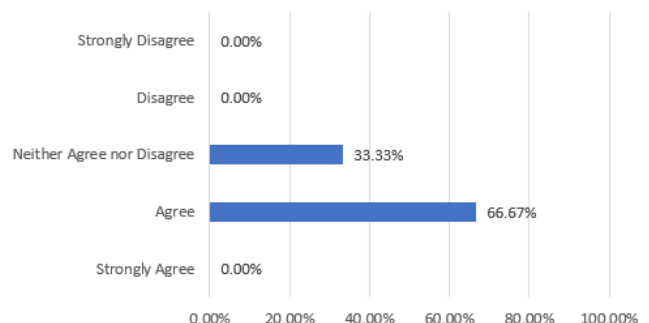

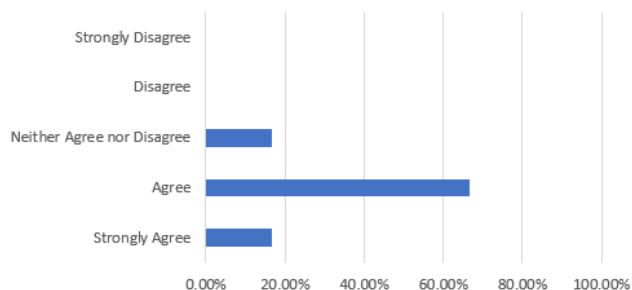

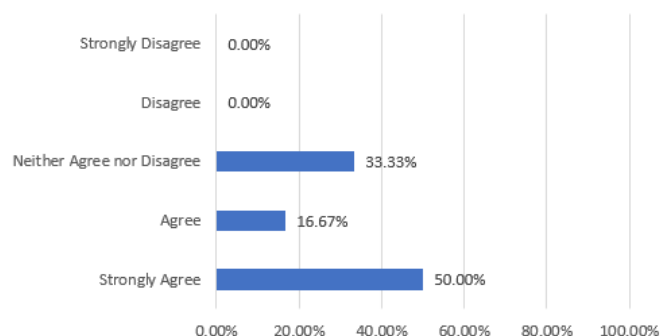

Outline of the Event

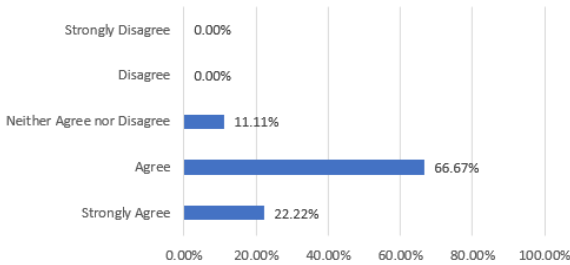

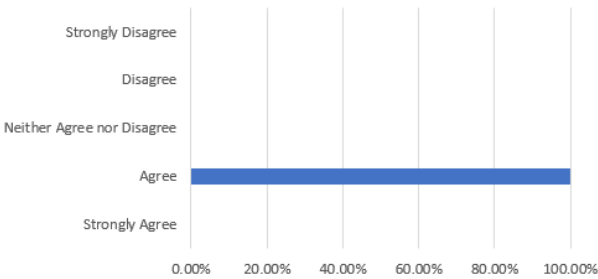
Labour Market Information was effectively used in the encounter

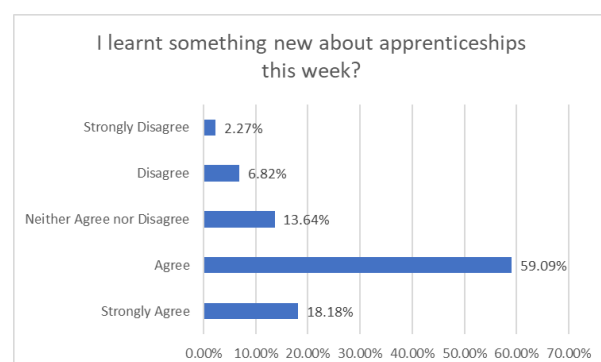
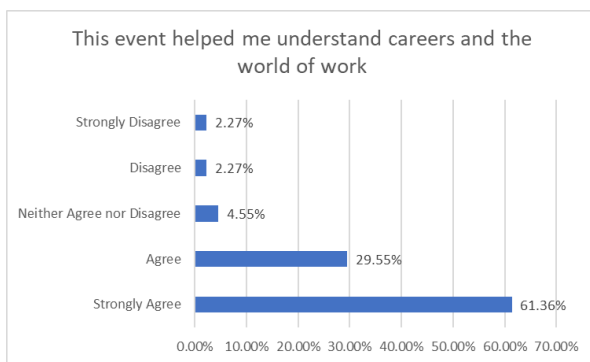
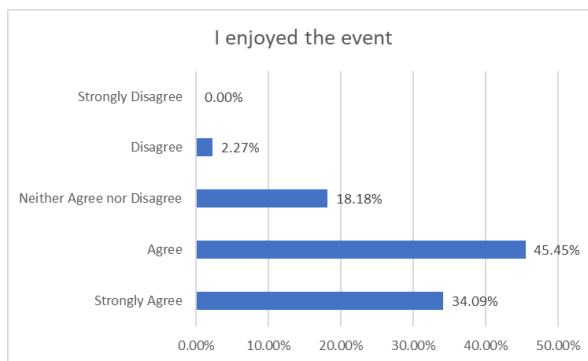
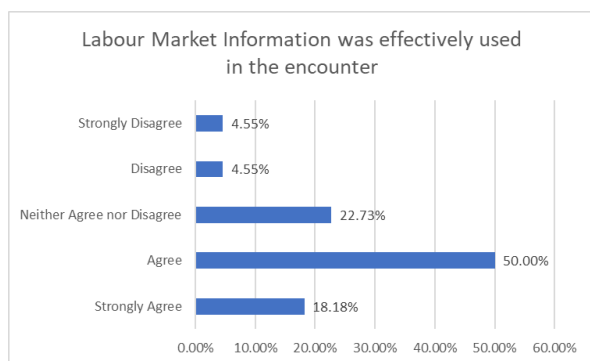
In line with the national events to raise the profile of apprenticeships, The Grove took part with their own programme of activities throughout the week.
