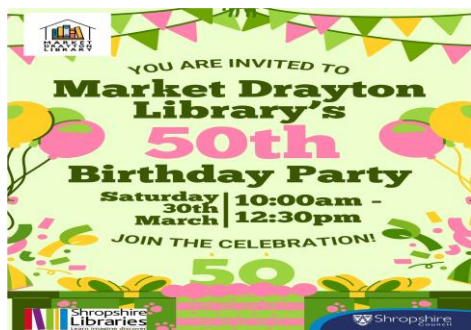
Comic Relief & RABI

This issue celebrates the recent term across our schools. It also includes an update from our CEO, Sarah Finch. Please have a read at the following link:

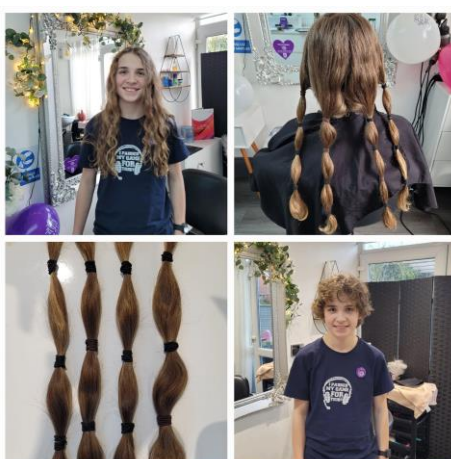
